An Opportunity to Help Shape Minnesota's Future

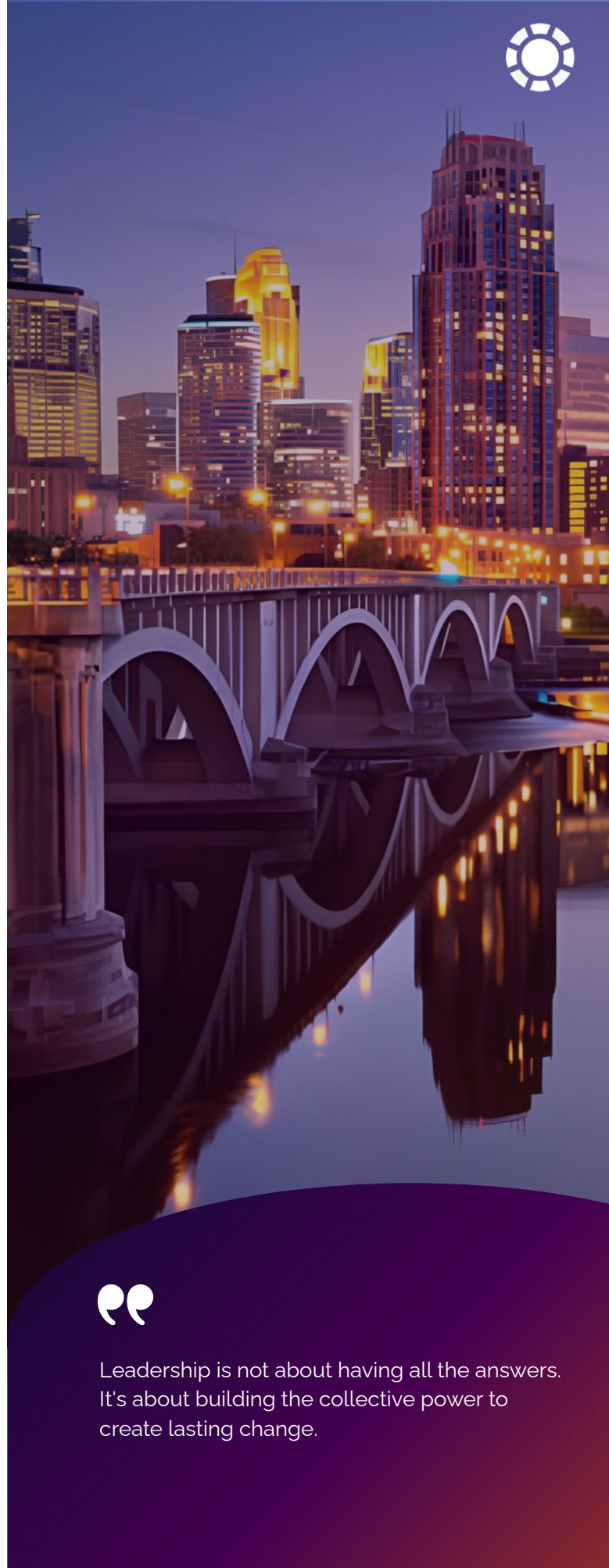
